Final Touch Gift Tags

PAPER CRAFT PATTERN

INCLUDES:

Instructions and pattern pieces to create your own **LARGE & SMALL GIFT TAGS.**

Get creative with these simple gift tag designs. Two tag sizes to choose from.

Project One Large Gift Tag

Materials List:

- 2 pieces of 12" x 12" double sided scrapbooking paper in coordinating patterns/colors (We used paper from Amy's Belle Paper Pad by K&Company - Product # 626263.)
- Adhesive (We used Wacky Tac Liquid Adhesive by K&Company - Product # 000902.)
- Decorative piece for the front of the tag (We used a letter from Amy's Belle Alphabet by K&Company - Product # 565791.)
- Embroidery Thread in a coordinating color



Tools Needed:

- Craft Knife
- Metal Ruler
- Cutting Mat
- Pencil
- Hole Punch
- Scissors

Finished Size:

Large Tag - 4 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Step 1.

CUT THE PIECES OUT OF YOUR PAPER

A. Trace your pattern pieces onto the scrapbooking paper as follows:

Paper #1:

- Trace 1 of the Large Gift Tag

Paper #2:

- Trace 1 of Piece A
- Trace 2 of Piece B

B. On your cutting mat, use your metal ruler as a guide and your craft knife to carefully cut out each of the pattern pieces that you just traced.

Step 2.

ASSEMBLE THE GIFT TAG

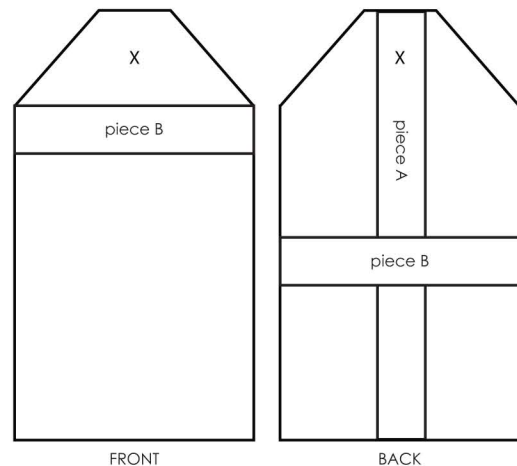
A. Apply adhesive to the **WRONG** sides of Piece A, 2 Piece B's, and the decorative chipboard letter, following drying and application instructions for your adhesive.

B. Place the 3 paper pieces onto the Large Gift Tag as shown in the diagram below.

C. Place the decorative chipboard letter, centered where Piece A and Piece B meet on the front of the Large Gift Tag.

D. Once all the pieces are attached, punch a hole with your hole punch through the layers, at the "X" on the Large Gift Tag.

E. Thread a length of the embroidery thread through the hole.



Your Large Gift Tag is complete!

Project Two Small Gift Tag

Materials List:

- 3 pieces of 12" x 12" double sided scrapbooking paper in coordinating patterns/colors (We used paper from Amy's Belle Paper Pad by K&Company - Product # 626263 and the Sola Paper Pad - Product # 626270.)
- Adhesive (We used Wacky Tac Liquid Adhesive by K&Company - Product # 000902.)
- Embroidery Thread in a coordinating color



Tools Needed:

- Craft Knife
- Metal Ruler
- Cutting Mat
- Pencil
- Hole Punch
- Scissors

Finished Size:

Small Tag - 3" x 2"

Step 1.

CUT THE PIECES OUT OF YOUR PAPER

A. Trace your pattern pieces onto the scrapbooking paper as follows:

Paper #1:

- Trace 1 of the Small Gift Tag
- Trace 1 of Piece D

Paper #2:

- Trace 1 of Piece A
- Trace 1 of Piece B

Paper #3:

- Trace 1 of Piece C

B. On your cutting mat, use your metal ruler as a guide and your craft knife to carefully cut out each of the pattern pieces that you just traced.

Step 2.

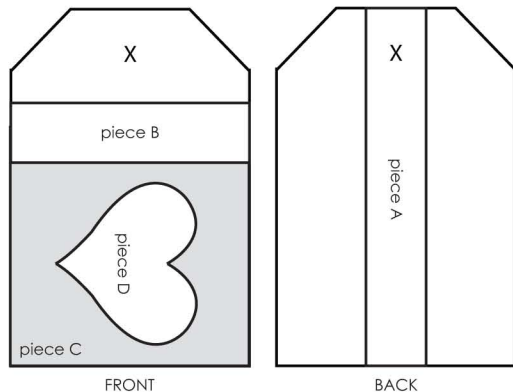
ASSEMBLE THE GIFT TAG

A. Apply adhesive to the **WRONG** side of Piece A, Piece B, Piece C, and Piece D, following drying and application instructions for your adhesive.

B. Place the pieces onto the Small Gift Tag as shown in the diagram below.

C. Once all the pieces are attached, punch a hole with your hole punch through the layers, at the "X" on the Small Gift Tag.

D. Thread a length of the embroidery thread through the hole.



Your Small Gift Tag is complete!

- Piece B - Paper 2 (cut 2)

- Piece B - Paper 2
- Piece C - Paper 3
- Piece D - Paper 1
